

WHERE ARE WE NOW?

The Next 75: Building for the Future campaign has steadily gained participants in this effort to prepare Camp to serve future generations of campers and their families. As of August 2023, 282 donors have pledged a total of \$3.8M! Praise the Lord! Because of COVID, plans to broadly publicize the campaign were curtailed; and subsequently, an increase in building and construction costs (in some cases up to 40%) has required Camp to re-examine its needs and obtain updated construction estimates. After much discussion and prayer, the Board of Directors has determined that the best path forward is to prioritize certain projects and concentrate on securing the funding for their completion and eliminate or put other projects on hold. Our updated goal and priorities are laid out below:

PRIORITY PROJECTS...

Multi Purpose Building in New Hampshire (\$2.75M):

This building will be equipped with a basketball court, stage, storage, and flexible seating to allow for all-camp programs that require indoor space — or outdoor programs, like chapel, that need to be brought inside due to inclement weather! It will also enhance our property as a more attractive retreat location to serve our Conference quests.



This dedicated space will give campers the opportunity to take a project from the design phase all the way to completion. The skills and craftsmanship learned will be useful for a lifetime.

WILD Pavilion at MRO (\$125,000):

WILD Participants spend almost 100% of their time outside, and that includes cooking two meals a day! This structure will provide a protected open air space for them to gather for Bible studies, leadership lessons, and cooking meals over the fire.



Energy Initiative: The Next 75 will finance modifications to existing buildings, and allow us to investigate new technologies and other ways of reducing energy costs as we strive to be better stewards of God's beautiful creation.

Staff Development: One of our most valued assets is our amazing staff. The Next 75 will provide a larger financial incentive to encourage experienced staff to return to serve for subsequent summers.

Inspiration Point Scholarship Endowment: A portion of the monies raised the The Next 75 will be used to boost this invested fund which provides for campers who need financial assistance to attend camp. (Gifts to this fund in the form of bequests or estate gifts are welcome.)
